

Key to subsections of sect. DALECHAMPIA

inflorescences always axillary;
Twining vines; involucre bracts white to green.

Invol. with 1 node below.

Leaves on flowering branches lobed or unlobed, never compound, bracts green, white,
or yellow-green.

Leaves on flowering branches lobed (at least in part); bracts
white to green; stam. involucre with 7-15 fls. subsect. Dalechampia
fls. 7-9.

Leaves on flowering branches unlobed; bracts green; stam. / Convolvuloideae

Leaves on flowering branches trifoliolate (unlobed leaves sometimes
present); bracts green; staminate flowers 7-9. Triphyllae

inflorescences mostly terminal;
Erect or decumbent subshrubs; involucre bracts white, pink, or yellow.

inflorescences mostly terminal;
Leaves lobed or unlobed; staminate involucre with 9-11 flowers. Humiles

Leaves palmately parted; staminate involucre with 7 flowers. Brevipedes

*Invol. with 2 or 3 nodes below; leaves 3-lobed; bracts
green;*
